

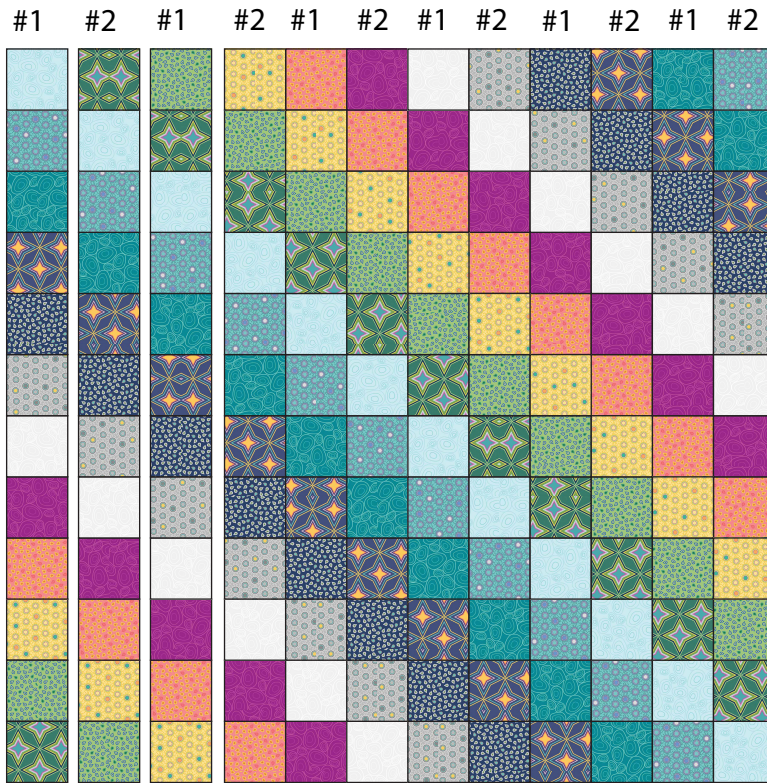

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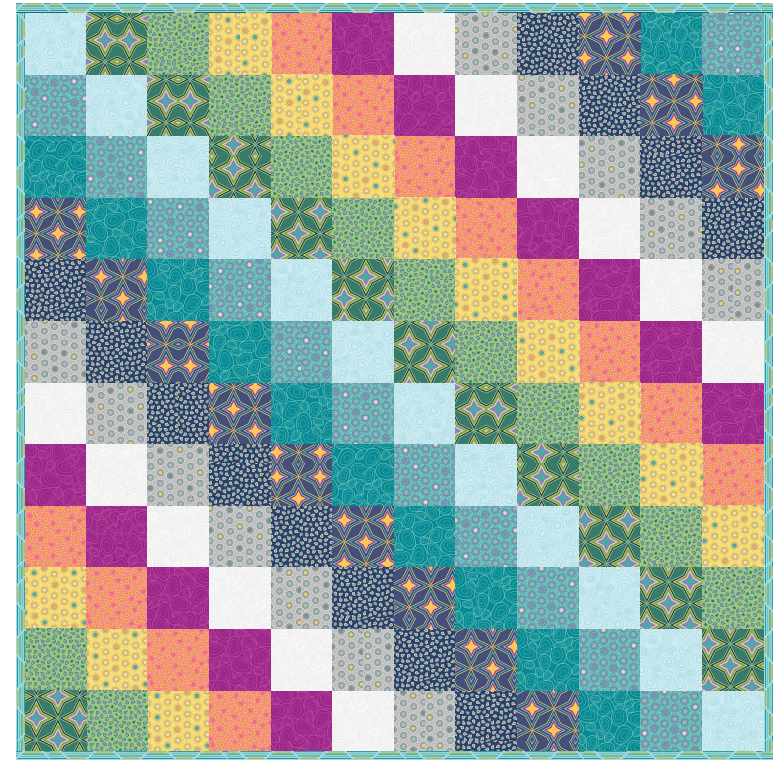


Baby Bargello Quilt

Pick out seam so indicated fabric square is on top in each vertical row.

Project Size:
42-1/2" square

Skill Level:
Confident Beginner

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What you need:

12 fat quarters, binding fabric, backing, batting, sewing machine, Sewing supplies

All seam allowances are 1/4".

All pieces are stitched with right sides together.

Yardage

(12) fat quarters

(2) additional fat quarters or 1/2 yard for binding

2-3/4 yards backing

48" square piece of batting

Cutting and Preparation

From each fat quarter:

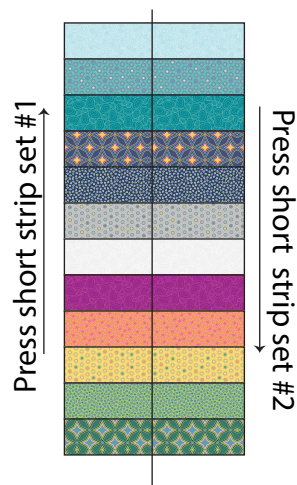
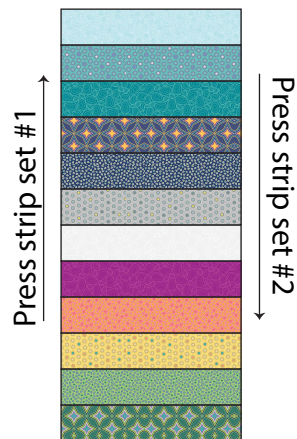
(3) 4" x WOF strips (at least 20" in length)

From the binding fabric:

(10) 2-1/4" x 21" strips (from FQs) or (5) 2-1/4" x WOF strips (from yardage)

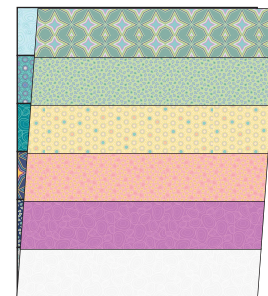
Making the Quilt

1. Noting fabric order, sew together (1) 4" x WOF strip of each fabric to make a strip set. Make (3). For Strip Set #1, press the seam allowances toward the top. For Strip Set #2, press the seam allowances toward the bottom.

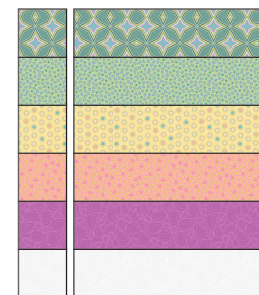


2. Before pressing the third strip set, cut it in half as shown to make (2) short strip sets. Press Short Strip Set #1 seams toward the top. Press Short Strip Set #2 seams toward the bottom.

3. Fold Strip Set #1 in half, right sides facing, so top and bottom edges are together, and sew to make a tube. Repeat with Short Strip Set #1.



4. Lay tubes flat on cutting mat. Using a ruler, square up one end and cut a 4"-wide loop. From the (2) #1 strip sets, cut a total of (6) #1 loops (seam allowances are pressed toward top).



5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 using the #2 strip sets (seam allowances are pressed toward bottom).

6. Referring to the Layout Diagram on the back page, use a seam ripper to pick out the seam of Loop #1 so the light aqua puddles square is at the top of the vertical row. For Loop #2, pick out the seam so the green star square is at the top of the vertical row. Continue opening loops so the indicated fabric is at the top, alternating #1 and #2 loops.

7. Lay out all (12) vertical rows in order, again referring to the Layout Diagram. Because you alternated #1 and #2 strips, the seam allowances should also alternate and will nest as you pin strips together.

8. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

Finishing

Layer the backing right side down, batting and quilt top right side up. Baste the layers and quilt as desired. Use the binding strips to bind the quilt.
