Project Notes

Finished quilt size:

63" x 78"

Materials:

(for full Block of the Month quilt)

- A: 7/8 yard mint solid
- B: 1-3/4 yards navy solid
- C: 2 yards white solid
- D: 7/8 yard olive solid
- E: 1-1/8 yards sand solid
- F: 1 yard brown solid
- G: 7/8 yard wedgewood solid
- H: 5/8 yard taupe solid
- I: 1/4 yard chocolate solid
- J: 1/4 yard caribbean solid
- K: 3/8 yard hunter solid
- 5 yards backing fabric
- 71" x 85" piece of batting

Notes:

- Keep all yardage and scrap pieces together until quilt is finished.
- This is a medallion-style quilt, so you'll start with center block and then add borders each month until the quilt is fully assembled.
- Refer to arrows in diagrams for seam pressing directions.
- RST = right sides together
- WOF = width of fabric

Cutting:

Fabric A (Mint):

(1) 6-1/2" square

Fabric B (Navy):

(8) 3-1/2" squares

Fabric C (White):

(4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces

(4) 3-1/2" squares

Month 1:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) 3-1/2" B squares. Place (1) marked square RST on the end of (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" C piece as shown. Stitch on the drawn line and trim seam allowance to 1/4" past the line. Press corner open.








2. Position a second marked square on the opposite end of the C piece as shown. Stitch on the drawn line and trim seam allowance to 1/4" past the line. Press corner open. Make (4) B-C units.





3. Sew B-C units to opposite sides of the 6-1/2" A square to make a center row.



Center row Make 1 4. Sew 3-1/2" C squares to both short ends of (1) B-C unit to make a top row. Repeat to make a bottom row.



Top/bottom row Make 2

5. Sew the top and bottom rows to the center row to complete the center small star block measuring 12-1/2" square.
