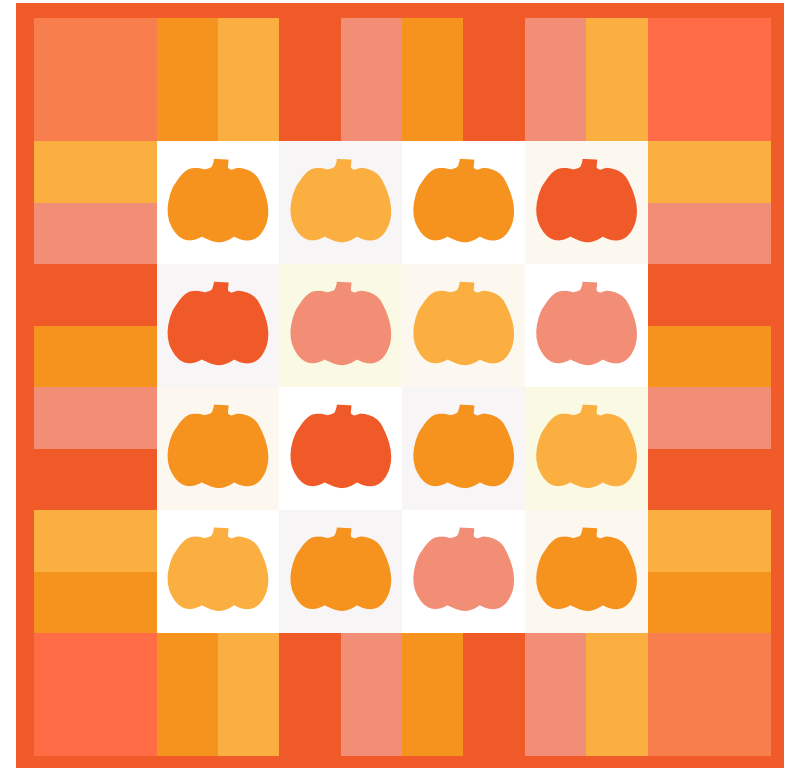

# SCRAPPY PUMPKIN PATCH



**Skill Level:**

Beginner

**What You'll Need:**

(2) 5" square packs, 1/3 yard binding fabric, 3/4 yard backing fabric, batting, fusible web, lightweight fusible interfacing and batting

All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ ".

All pieces are stitched with right sides together.

WOF stands for Width of Fabric

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## Cutting

### From the 5" orange squares:

(4) 4-1/2" squares for border corners

(32) 2-1/2" x 5" rectangles for border

Reserve remaining squares for applique

### From binding fabric:

(3) 2-1/4" x WOF strips

### From the lightweight fusible interfacing:

(16) 4-1/2" squares

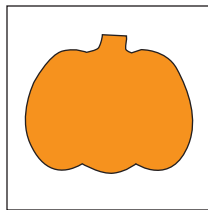
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## Make the Pumpkin Blocks

1. Trace (16) pumpkin templates onto the paper side of fusible web. Cut out each shape 1/2" past the drawn line.

2. Fuse the pumpkin shapes onto the wrong side of (16) 5" orange squares. Cut out each pumpkin on the drawn line.

3. Center and fuse (1) pumpkin onto (1) 5" white square. Fuse (1) 4-1/2" square of fusible interfacing to the wrong side of the white square. Make (16).

4. Using coordinating thread and a zig zag stitch, stitch around the outer edge of each pumpkin to secure it to the white square.

5. Square up each pumpkin block to 4-1/2" square.

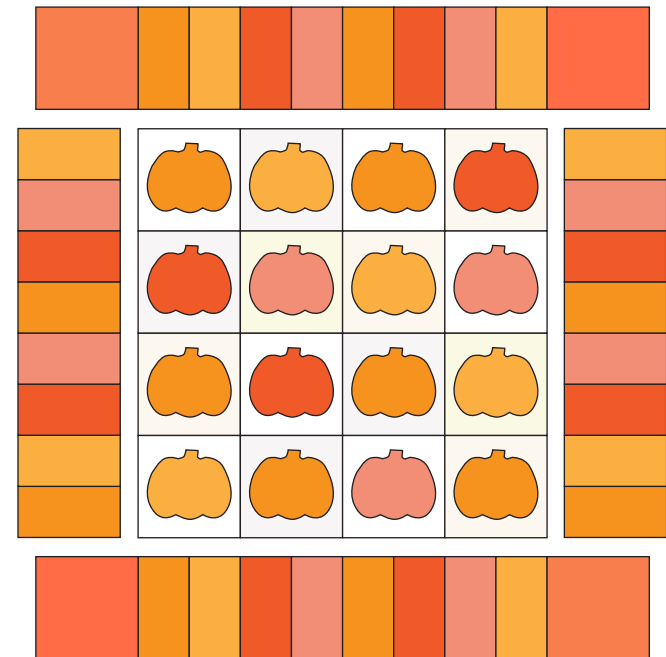
## Assemble the Quilt

1. Lay out the pumpkin blocks in (4) rows of (4). Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.

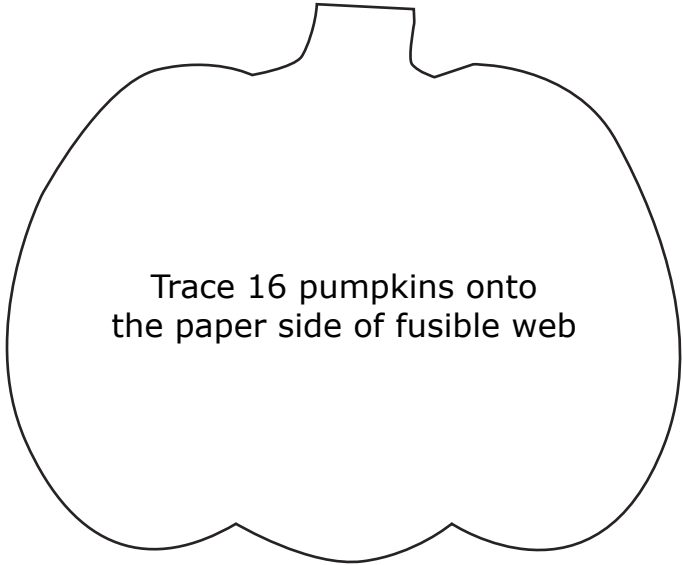
2. Sew (8) 2-1/2" x 5" orange rectangles together along long edges to make a pieced border. Make (4). Trim each border width to measure 4-1/2" (each pieced border should measure 4-1/2" x 16-1/2").

3. Sew pieced borders to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew 4-1/2" orange squares to both ends of the remaining pieced borders. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.

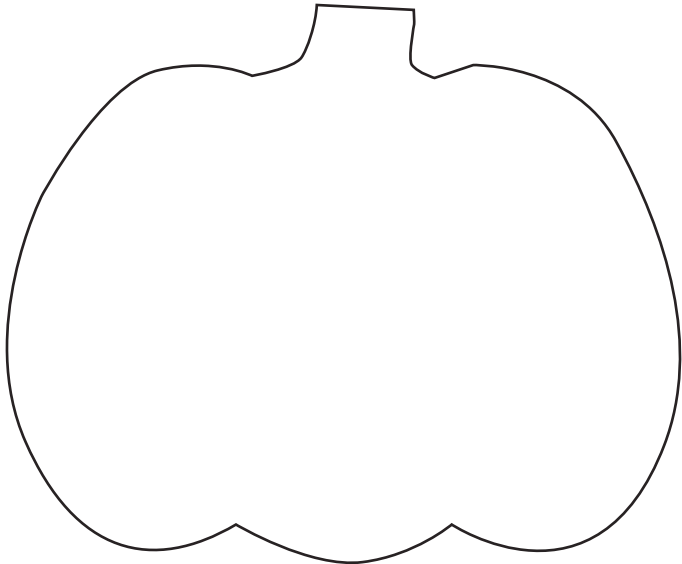
4. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing and baste layers together. Quilt as desired. Use the (3) 2-1/4" x WOF strips to bind the quilt. Enjoy!
